The City of Morro Bay is encouraging residents to share their thoughts on what they believe the community's visions and values are through an innovative survey available throughout the city.

Morro Bay has partnered with "21st Century digital government" organization Code for America to deploy CityVoice, a survey platform in which community members can phone in and share their thoughts. The initial version of the survey will be used to gauge Morro Bay residents' and visitors' thoughts on the community's Vision & Values statements. These statements will inform

the coming updates to the City's General Plan and, hopefully, most major decisions moving forward.

The survey will be live from Thursday, Sept. 17, to October 12. It may run longer if the City feels more input could be gathered. Signs posted throughout the community will invite people to participate. ## City prepares community enhancement program



The City of Morro Bay is preparing a new code enforcement program — often referred to as "community enhancement" — to ensure that nuisances and other code violations related to public health and safety are remedied efficiently and professionally.

Right now the city is finalizing hiring of several part-time code enforcement employees who will be the City's main representatives on community enhancement. Over an initial three-month period (beginning in October), the focus of their work will be outreach and education, ensuring that those who may have a code violation are aware of it and have a chance to learn how it can be fixed. The City is working to post the "Top 10" most common concerns from community members online with fliers that provide information on how to remedy those issues.
