ANNOUNCEMENT FOR PLANNING INTERN

The City of Morro Bay is pleased to announce we are currently recruiting for a planning internship position. Under general administrative direction from the Community Development Director, the successful candidate will perform a wide variety of planning tasks. Recruitment runs through Friday June 11, 2021 or until the position is filled. Interviews will be scheduled for the week of June 21, 2021.

JOB DESCRIPTION: The position will work on current planning projects or long-range planning projects depending on experience and qualifications. The general task expectations of this position are as follows:

- Provide support to the development of an updated Short Term Rental Ordinance
- Answer Planning counter questions and zoning inquiries
- Serve as project planner for sign permit applications, temporary use permits, remodels and additions and new single family homes
- Plan review for consistency with the General Plan, Local Coastal Plan, Waterfront Master Plan, Specific Plans, Subdivision Ordinance and Zoning Ordinance
- Conduct research for various projects either current, or long range
- Preparation of Graphics, Maps and Powerpoint presentations

SKILLS:

- Computer programs; Word, Excel, Powerpoint. Preference given for applicants with background in GIS and graphic design.
- General office procedures; answering phones, copying, filing
- Be able to follow direction as well as take self-initiative, must be courteous, polite and enjoy meeting and talking with people both in-person and on the phone.
